CO is invisible and has no smell. CO can make you very sick if you breathe it.

Breathing CO can make you feel like you have the flu. Watch for these clues that CO is in your air:

- small headache that keeps getting worse
- feeling more and more tired and maybe even confused
- stomach ache that keeps getting worse. You might throw up. Yuk!
- heart beating faster

If you feel like this, it's important to go outside right away.

If fresh air makes you feel better, there may be CO in your home.

Stay out of the house. Call your fire department or 911 right away.

They will check your home for CO.
